"The top Southern Oregon red in our tasting is a dandy from Gino Cuneo, who uses fruit from Del Rio Vineyard, which has quickly gained favor among Willamette Valley wineries. This big, spicy Syrah is layered with aromas of dark fruit and oak and bold, jammy blueberry flavors. Don't think about it, just buy it; don't prevaricate over it, just drink it; don't be a fool, cellar some of it!"
